

- Fought off most regulatory challenges






- 22 proposals

- Only 4 are definite non-starters
- Of those, only minimum staffing is major threat





- Workers are not available
- Funding is not there





- RN: 0.55 HPRD
- Nurse Aide (NA): 2.45 HPRD
- No specific LPN requirement
- 24/7 RN
- If acuity needs of residents require more, higher RN and NA staffing level will also be required





- 49% do not meet 0.55 RN HPRD
- 72% do not meet 2.45 NA HPRD
- 19% meet both RN & NA HPRD
- Estimate <20% facilities have 24/7 RN hours oPBJ has per day, not shift-level data




# Medicare Advantage Penetration Grew from 37% to 45%, 2019 – 2022





## LTC Provider Led I-SNPs Continue to Grow As Providers Seek More Leadership in PHM


AHCA Provider Led I-SNPs and Non-Provider Led I-SNP Growth


**Population Growth – 80-84 Years** 








## **US** Population In Decline








- Caregiver support ratio represents the 45-64 population divided by the 80+ population. This means there will be less people to care for the 80+ population causing more seniors to seek housing and care outside of their home.
- At any point, 6 percent of adult children serve as caregivers, and 17 percent will take on this role at some point in their lives
- Those who do provide care devote an average of 77 hours per month, which can take a toll on both the finances and health of the caregiver.
